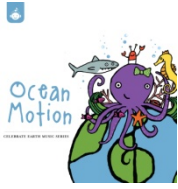
If I were a whale I would excel

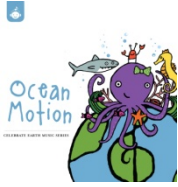

I never want to live on dry land again

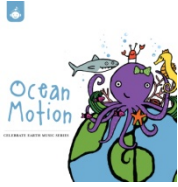

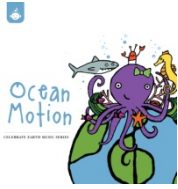
A sea lion doesn't roar he just barks

The Watercycle

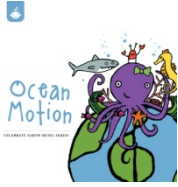

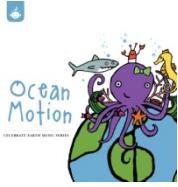
Stitching through the waves

Pay the gobies by feeding them too

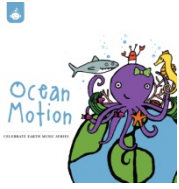

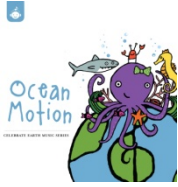
From the rivers to the oceans

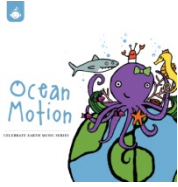
For all my life, most of my life in the valley I have been

Who floats around in otter space

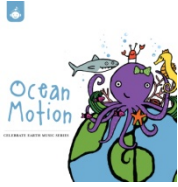
So don't wait for this world to change
